***A Cabin in the Woods***

We offer six intimate real log cabins for nightly or weekly rental year-round. Our cabins circle a peaceful meadow and are placed well back from the road. Each cabin features a full kitchen with range, refrigerator, microwave, coffeemaker, cookware, dinnerware and utensils. Each also has a gas fireplace, gas barbeque, an old-fashioned clawfoot bathtub, towels, bedding, a gas barbeque, and a porch with breathtaking views.

Five have lofts and comfortably sleep up to four people. Our sixth, which has a view of Harney Peak, is a two bedroom and can sleep up to eight. The cabins are placed a short distance apart to afford peace and privacy.

### ***Only the Sound of Music***

Relaxing is the number one pursuit of many of our guests. We do, however, provide radios and stereo CD players, so bring your favorite music.



### ***A Little Ranch History***

Newton Fork Ranch is a third-generation property just outside Hill City in the beautiful and pristine Black Hills of South Dakota.

Situated on Deerfield Road, the Ranch is a series of old mining claims originally owned in the late 1800s by the Harney Peak Tin Mining Company of New York and London, England. Time truly stands still here.

Your mind can wander back to an era before South Dakota was a state and this property was located in Dakota Territory.



### ***A Creek Runs Through It***

The Newton Fork Creek meanders through the Ranch and is alive with pan-size rainbow trout. If you are ambitious, walk next door and pan for gold at Wade's Gold Mill, a popular destination for visitors in search of The Old West experience.

### ***Hiking and Biking Trail***

Once you catch up on your relaxing, you are ready to enjoy the surrounding area, which abounds with recreational pursuits.

We are conveniently located next to the George S. Mickelson Trail. Over a hundred years ago, the old Cheyenne to Deadwood stage ran through Newton Fork Ranch. Later, the Burlington Northern Railroad took its place heading up to Deadwood and the Homestake Gold Mine in Lead. Now, the abandoned railroad tracks have been turned into a popular hiking and biking trail that stretches 109 miles from Deadwood in the north to Edgemont in the south. One can explore the Black Hills on foot, bicycle, horseback, and in winter, on cross county skis and snowshoes. A gate on the property, installed for the exclusive use of our guests, opens directly onto the Mickelson Trail.

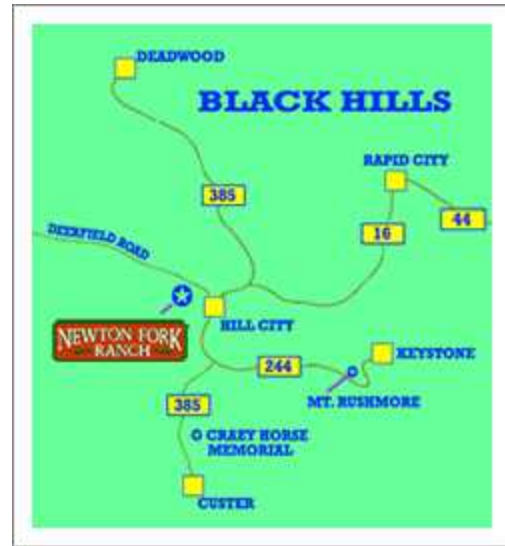
### ***Local Sightseeing***

Hill City prides itself on being situated in the Heart of the Black Hills. We are nine miles from historic Mount Rushmore National Memorial and 12 miles from Crazy Horse Memorial. Sylvan Lake, Custer State Park and a host of other popular attractions are also nearby.



### ***Hill City***

Newton Fork Ranch is located one-half mile outside of Hill City, a popular destination for visitors in search of art, crafts and good food. Hill City was founded in the late 1800s as a mining camp. The town thrived until gold was discovered in Deadwood. After that, as legend would have it, all that was left in Hill City was one old miner and a dog. Now, Main Street is once again alive with art galleries, renowned artists, Black Hills gold jewelers, gift shops, coffee houses, and fine restaurants. Don't miss taking a ride on the 1880 Train to Oblivion and Keystone.
